2020 BOONE FALL ACTIVITIES GUIDELINES

*These will be additional guidelines and specifications that pertain to Boone Community School District Facilities. They are added as an extension to the agreed upon RRC Guidelines established by the conference.

Face Coverings: *Face Coverings are **Required** to be worn by all event spectators.

*Need to be worn at the gate when purchasing tickets.

*BHS Booster Club will have disposable masks available for \$1.00 *BHS Logo Masks: Available in concession stands for \$5.00

Facility Seat Capacity: *Limited to 50% seating capacity.

*Blue tape will be used to mark off restricted bleacher areas.

Football (Goeppinger Field)

-No crossover between home/visitor sides

-Every other row seating

-Pods will be sectioned off for grass seating

-Designated spaces against the fence

Volleyball/Swimming (HS/MS)

-First two rows of bleachers are restricted.

-Every other row seating.

-Follow social distancing cones

Student Section: *Will be organized into pods for grades 9-12. **Masks Required**

*There will be **No Middle School Section**

*All students K-8 must be accompanied by and sit with an adult.

*Movement will be limited.

Concession Stand: *Both Home/Visitor Stands and Restrooms will be open.

*Stands will only be offering pre-packaged food and drink. *Follow physical distancing markers while waiting in line.
